CONGRESSIONAL LEADERS TO SPEARHEAD NATIONWIDE SALUTE TO CHARTER SCHOOLS

(Washington, DC 3/27/01) Members of Congress will again join in the nationwide celebration of charter school on the occasion of the second annual National Charter Schools Week, to be celebrated this year from April 30-May 4, 2001, announced CER president Jeanne Allen today.
