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Introduction A Message from CER's President

More than 450 new charter schools opened to serve kids in 32 states last year, representing a dramatic 15 percent increase in the nation's charter schools. Charter schools are new, innovative public schools that are accountable for student results. They are a critical part of the nation's educational landscape, and now with the addition of the new schools in this publication, nearly 3,400 charters serve close to a million students in communities across the country.

This new resource is provided as a supplement to The Center for Education Reform's *National Charter School Directory*, and with its release we are celebrating one of the most significant increases in these new public schools in recent years. Communities are not looking at education the same way they did 100 years ago. Today, there is a rapidly evolving landscape where parents can choose from a number of options for their kids, and where charter schools have successfully emerged to serve all kids.

Pioneer charter school states such as California and Minnesota continued to see rapid growth in charter schools this past year. In California, 81 new charter schools opened which serve more than 16,000 students, bringing its charter school count to well over 500 schools. New York City alone could see up to 20 charter schools opening in the coming year. And in a successful move, both New Hampshire and Iowa opened their first charter schools last year.

While parents, educators and lawmakers still face challenges from forces defending the status quo, it's impossible to ignore the enormous impact that charter schools have had on education reform in this country, which is evident in just a cursory glance at this supplement.
