15 Years and Still A Nation at Risk? Prominent Education Reformers Convene to Assess Condition of U.S. Schools

Diverse coalition of business leaders, activists and policymakers to appraise the state of American education fifteen years after "A Nation At Risk" and discuss a comprehensive reform agenda.

(Washington, DC; April 1, 1998) On Friday, April 3, thirty of the nation's most prominent education reformers, business leaders and policymakers will be joined by three former Commission members and staff of the 1983 A Nation at Risk report. Upon calling this meeting, William J. Bennett, co-director of Empower America said, "The nation's dismal showing on the Third International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) is among the most alarming education results of the last 15 years. Clearly we need to be concerned. And clearly, we need to act."

The group will discuss the findings of the '83 report, assess and compare the state of education today, and determine actions and recommend suitable solutions.
